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Privanova's role

Privanova has two main roles in CC-DRIVER.

Firstly, we focus on the Privacy, Data Protection and Ethics Compliance. We take part in WP6 on Ethics, Data Protection and Socio-Economic Impact Assessment. Here we lead the efforts around the management of the Ethics Advisory Board. We help the consortium address the Ethics Requirements received during the evaluation phase of the proposal. We also contribute to tasks on performing the Ethical, Privacy and Socio-Economic Impact Assessment.

Secondly, we leverage our experience and network of Law Enforcement Experts. We lead the CC-DRIVER's Stakeholders' Advisory Board and ensure liaison between its experts and the consortium partners during requirements analysis, project implementation and piloting phases.

CC-DRIVER aims to educate and divert youth from crime. It investigates Cybercrime-as-a-Service and provides decisionmakers and citizens with a shared view of its impacts on our society and what we can do to overcome them.
