

Privanova is part of the SECUR: a multidisciplinary project run by an international consortium and co-funded by the EU within the Digital Europe Programme 2022.

SECUR-EU adopts a proactive methodology to combat cybercriminal activities. The project addresses both offensive and defensive aspects of cybersecurity. On one hand, it enhances existing scanning and pen-testing tools, and on the other, it develops SIEM/IPS/IDS systems for critical infrastructures. SECUR-EU conducts adversary simulation sessions to train security experts. Additionally, artificial intelligence is leveraged to improve pen-testing tools and intrusion detection systems, with a strong emphasis on facilitating data sharing among stakeholders through a user-friendly dashboard.
